## Principle Provisions of Budget 2014



Free GP Care for children aged five and under costing €37m



**Telephone Allowance will cease** for all individuals in receipt of the Household Benefits Package.



Medical card eligibility curtailed for 70+ by lowering income thresholds to €900 p.w. for a couple and €500 p.w. for a single person



Jobseekers & Supplementary
Welfare Allowance reduced
to €100 for existing recipients who
reach 22 and for new entrants aged



Review of eligibility for all medical card holders to save €113m



Rate of Maternity Benefit standardised at a reduced €230 p.w. from January, 2014.



**Increase in D.I.R.T.**Raised from 33% to 41%



€850 Bereavement Grant eliminated from January 2014.



**Home Renovation Tax Incentive Scheme** for improvements and renovations.



**Tax relief for medical insurance** premiums will be restricted to €1,000 for an adult & €500 for a child.



**9% VAT rate to remain in place** for the hospitality sector



Prescription Charges increased to €2.50



**Additional Pension Levy** of 0.15% in 2014 and 2015.



Number of days before which individuals qualify for Sick Benefit increased from three to six days.
